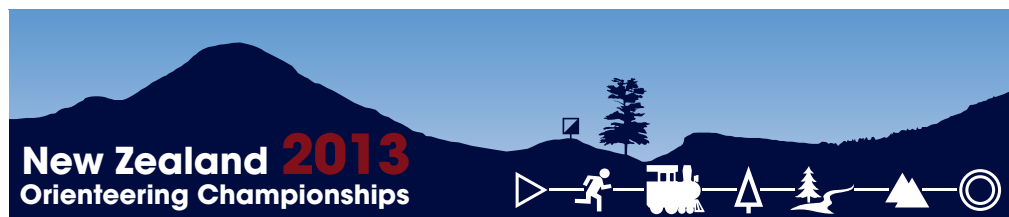

### **INCIDENT REPORT**

In the final event of 2012, at Akaroa, a competitor was hit by a car. PAPO's review found that its procedures are up-to-date and are being applied but it is a timely reminder to all clubs to ensure that this is also the case with their events. # PAPO's early beginnings

Hi: I read with interest the Press article relating to Chris Forne's exploits and programme for the PAPO Club. Its hard to believe that the club will soon be approaching its 40th year.

Out of interest I then checked the Clubs web site and scrolled through the info available. Again it was of great interest to read the initial history. However while it may appear minor, planning for the first orienteering event as part of the Councils Family Leisure week was well under way even before the NZO and the Davies were associated. A letter had already gone to the NZ association asking for advice and guidance. It was somewhat amazing that as the letter had been sent to the NZ office the the Davies made contact and arrived in ChCh to look at how orienteering could be started. I can remember thinking when John phoned (on arrival in Chch) wow this organisation is on the ball and is quick to respond. I remember the Davies and I joked in the end as it appeared the letters crossed in the mail. We had already borrowed flags and clippers from someone at Burnham MC to assist with the first course and I had talked to a cartographer (I think it was John Macdonald) at ChCh University re maps.

My interest in orienteering (or map reading) stemmed from being an Outward Bound instructor prior to starting with the Council in 1975 and previously an outdoor MSC bushcraft instructor. While not trying to detract from the wonderful assistance the Davies provided many of the first committee were the backbone who provided assistance in those early days after that first event. It was obvious from the first event that there were people who wanted more. We used Bottle Lake Forest Park for the next couple of events one with great hilarity or embarrassment. Part of the course went through the sand hills which unbeknown to us when we put flags out that morning, went right through an area that attracted a number of nudists sunning themselves in the afternoon sun.

My wife and I were heartened to see her fathers trophy (Bob Alexander) still figuring. Bob apart from being a NZ Grandprix motor cycle racer in his earlier days at Cust, was not an active sports person, until the Orienteering Club was established. He had just turned 65 and retired starting jogging (even though he cycled everywhere) to be capable of ensuring he would complete an orienteering course. It was really great to see how enthusiastic a keen orienteer he was. Sadly about 18 months after the club was well underway he died.

Well on that note I'll finish and wish the Club another successful season.

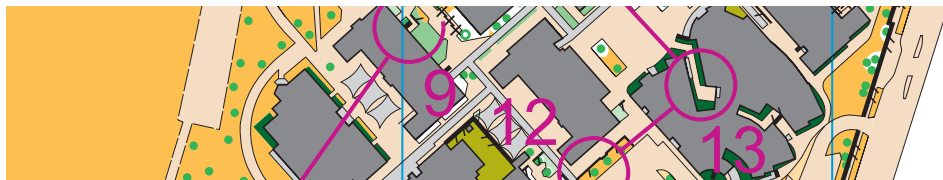

## General Information

**\*WHISTLES \*** **EVERYONE** please note that carrying a whistle while running a course is recommended.

**Cancellations** - Events are usually only cancelled in the event of extreme conditions such as heavy snow, flooding, dangerous river conditions etc., which are more likely to affect mountain areas. Should an event be cancelled, **NewstalkZB 1098 AM** will be notified. Cancellations are repeated half-hourly from 6 am, then hourly from 9 am.

**Start times** - vary and are published in the event notices. For most club events registration is from 10am, the first start is 10:30am and the last start is 1:00pm. Course closure is 2.30pm so late starters only have 90 minutes for their run.

**Finishing and Course Closure** - Please remember to always come to the finish area, whether you finished your course or not and hand in your control card or punch the finish box, so that we can account for everyone who started. Course closure is the time at which you **MUST** have returned to the finish area even if you have not yet completed your course. It is at this time that the organisers may start taking in controls (and looking for you if you have not returned).

**Helpers** - All members are asked to be helpers during the year. The Volunteer Co-ordinator will contact you by email or by phone and the Chief Organiser will contact you shortly afterwards to make arrangements. Please contact them when you arrive at the event. Helpers who set up/pack up/work on registration may opt for a free run on the day or receive VIP points.

**Control collection** - Please offer to collect controls at the end of the event and receive VIP points.

**Dogs** - No dogs on Farmland please!

**Permanent Courses:** Three are available, with options to suit a wide range of abilities, including beginners/children and experienced orienteers. **Victoria Park:** maps (\$3.50) and full instructions are available at the Christchurch City Council Beckenham Service Centre, 66 Colombo St. (Open normal business hours; ph: 332-3099) and at the Port Hills Visitor Centre, Victoria Park. Groups planning to use the Course should let the Ranger know beforehand by phoning 332-9889. **Spencer Park:** maps and instructions are available at the Spencer Park Camp Shop, \$3 each. **Hokitika:** a park and street map outside CHCH but under PAPO's care. Starting in Cass Square Hokitika. Maps are available (FREE!) from the Hokitika Visitor Information Centre (i-site) or Westland District Council. You will need a pencil to write down the codes on the control.

**Library** - The club has a collection of orienteering books etc. available for members to borrow in the caravan. General introduction to orienteering, plus training, coaching, course setting, fitness, and rogaining are covered by the 16 or so titles on the list. Some are older 10-20 year-old "classics", but we have recently added some new publications. **In addition, look on the website → Web Page Links → 'the Little Book of Orienteering Techniques'.**
