General Information

- **SportIdent AIR** (SIAC) punching system will be used for all events. SI/SIAC cards must be cleared and checked before each race. Clear/Check stations will be available at the start.
- Starts will be at one minute start intervals for competitors wanting to race
 individually, however there will be an option at the Le Bons Bay event for a mass
 start, and the option for a chasing start at the Gardens of Tane event. For this
 event we will produce a start list based on the accumulative times from the
 events on Saturday.
- Once competitors **finish**, they must download, whether or not they completed the whole course. If you are hiring an SI Card, please make sure this is returned after you have downloaded.


Saturday 30 November: Little River Sprint

Arena and Parking:

The event arena will be located at Little River School, accessible from Western Valley Road. Parking will be at the domain adjacent to the school, and will be signposted. There are public toilets at the event centre.

Please do not park near the Fire Station at the domain. This area needs to be kept clear.

The start will be an 850m walk from the event centre along the main road. Please take care and stick to the footpath.

Course Details

There will be a maze area that all courses will go into. There are many controls in the maze, so it is important to check your codes! The maze has been mapped with the impassable wall symbol, so make sure not to jump over any tapes. It is right by the finish so people will be watching:)

Map Notes/Hazards

Many areas of this map have been updated since its last use. Parts of this course are close to the state highway and car parks and have been planned with safety in mind however please take great care and give way to all vehicles. Please be aware of foot traffic, as the courses will navigate around operating businesses.

Courses will enter an area with old trains. The tracks are safe to run around but take caution when running between carriages. Gaps that are not safe to pass through are mapped as impassable.

All courses will pass through an untimed road crossing. You must listen to the marshals and move through the crossing with care. And no checking your maps!!



Arena and Parking:



The event arena will be located at the Le Bons Bay Domain, accessible from Le Bons Bay Road. Parking will be at the arena. Public toilets will be available at the event centre, along with the use of the community hall.

Start: The start will be located at the event centre.

The hard course has been designed as a butterfly loop mass start. This mass start will take place at 6:00pm, with the medium and easy courses starting afterwards as usual.

Map Notes/Hazards

The map is a small area of parkland, pine forest and tussock sand dunes. There will be lots of controls in a small area, so checking the control code is important. This event will take place when daylight is low, so a headtorch may be needed in the forested area. Look out for low hanging branches and general forest hazards.

Camping

Camping will be available at the Le Bons Bay domain after the evening sprint on Saturday. Facilities inside the Le Bons Bay community hall are available to use, but limited so please be aware when packing the cars! Plenty of space to pitch tents and the weather is looking great! Only \$10 per person, and please ensure all rubbish is taken away so we can use this space again in the future!

Arena and Parking:

The event arena will be located at the Akaroa School, accessible from Rue Jolie. Parking is in the streets adjacent to the school. There will be public toilets on the way to the start, around 300m from the event centre.

Start: There will be a 1km walk to the start along a road. Follow the signs, and you must stick to the footpath when there is one available.

Course Details

All chasing start runners need to be at the start by 10:50am so everyone can be organised and it can run smoothly. (Helps if you write your start time on your hand!)

A start list for the Hard course Chasing Start will be created after the end of the Le Bons Bay Pivot Race. Note that any mispunch in the first two races of the weekend will not exclude you from the chasing start. A 2 minute time penalty will be added per mispunch, so you will have to work hard to get your time back! There will be a 20 minute cut-off for the chasing start to keep things moving along. All others will be in a mass start at 11:20am. First person over the line at the Akaroa School will be crowned champion for the weekend!

Map Notes/Hazards

The start of these courses runs through a cemetery. The graves are mapped as Out of Bounds and all competitors must stay off these areas. Be aware of other park users, and some trails may be slippery or overgrown.

All courses will pass through an untimed road crossing. You must listen to the marshals and move through the crossing with care. And no checking your maps!!

The hard course has a route option down a large earth bank. Although in the rules this is a passable feature, it is quite a drop (for mountain bikes), and care must be taken if you choose this route!
